Synopses:

Winter's Fresh Kiss is a re-kindling of pleasure, through childhood memories, of our physical relationship to the winter landscape. This interdisciplinary production features a raw style of contemporary dance in collaboration with a video artist, visual artist, fashion designer, and DJ. Imagine four strong snow faeries sliding head-first down a steep and snowy aspen forest with the help of their designer crazy aprons and the fresh trip hop beats of the *Winter's Fresh Kiss* Soundtrack.

Danielle McCulloch is currently teaching others to enjoy the movements of their own bodies at The Movement Studio in Vancouver. She also teaches somatic applications to aspiring teachers of various movement disciplines. She attended the Alberta College of Art and Design, graduated with distinction from the University of Calgary Dance Program, is a registered Somatic Movement Therapist, CranioSacral Therapist and Pilates Method Alliance certified teacher. McCulloch's choreographic and performance career, spanning over 10 years, took her to many stages in Calgary, Edmonton, Vancouver, Toronto and Italy. Her later works focused on establishing the mixed media collective, Colour For Industry.
